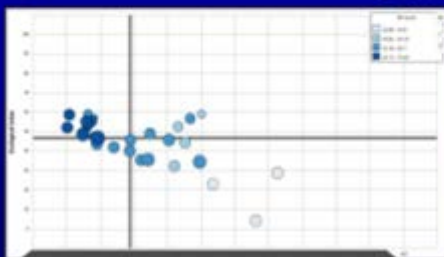

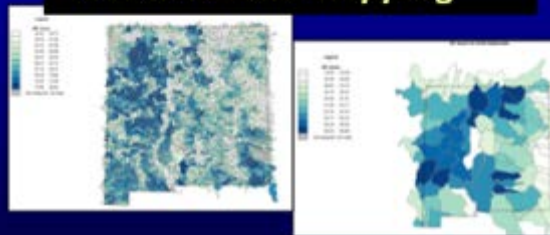

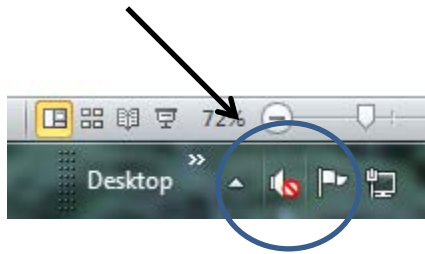

ACWA, ECOS, and ASWM Send House Leadership Letter Highlighting Concerns About H.R. 3043, Hydropower Policy Modernization Act of 2017

The Association of State Wetland Managers signed on to a letter with the Environmental Council of States (ECOS) and the Association of Clean Water Administrators (ACWA) raising concerns about provisions of H.R. 3043, the Hydropower Policy Modernization Act of 2017. If enacted as written, the draft bill would modify Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) licensing requirements under the Federal Power Act and may conflict with state authority under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act to protect water quality and provide critical input on federal dredge and fill permits to wetlands and other waters under § 404. ASWM Comments on Proposal to Rescind the 2015 Clean Water Rule

The Association of State Wetland Managers has responded to the request for comments on the rule proposed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Army to rescind the 2015 Clean Water Rule and replace it with the regulations and guidance that were previously in place. Comments are due by Wednesday, September 27.
